

Can the water dispenser locker be disinfected

For disinfecting, sanitize the dispenser with equal parts white vinegar and water or 1 tablespoon of unscented bleach per gallon of water. Fill the reservoir with the solution and let it sit for 2-5 minutes.

Drain the unit's reservoir and thoroughly clean the unit in accordance with manufacturer's recommendations or you can get the dispenser cleaned or serviced by an outside service provider.

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Clean spigots, bottle receptacle and cabinet with 70% rubbing alcohol or food surface quality disinfecting wipes. Vacuum or wipe the grill on the back of the dispenser to remove any dust.

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
