Why do Estonians have electricity plans?

Most Estonians have electricity plans linked to the current spot price, enabling them to respond to hourly price fluctuations and manage their consumption more efficiently. Estonia is an active participant in the European Union's electricity market. This integration is pivotal for the country's energy policy and market dynamics.

How much does electricity cost in Estonia?

The chart below displays the hourly electricity prices for Estonia. Estonia is 3.13 cents per kilowatt-hour (kWh).

Is Estonia part of Nord Pool's open electricity market?

Estonia is part of Nord Pool's open electricity market together with Norway, Sweden, Finland, Denmark, Latvia and Lithuania (see map). In the open electricity market (power exchange), the price of electricity is formed as a result of supply and demand. There is at least one price area in each country, in a larger country there may be several.

Why do Estonians use smart meters?

Over 98% of Estonian households are equipped with smart meters, following European Union regulations. These advanced meters provide real-time data on electricity usage, measuring consumption hourly. The widespread adoption of smart meters allows consumers to be more informed about their energy usage.

To correctly calculate the electricity bill, Nord Pool Spot's 15-minute interval prices must be shifted one hour forward to reflect electricity consumption in the Estonian time zone.

If you are charging an electric vehicle once a day, it will cost you a total of EUR270.3 per month. If you decide to charge your electric vehicle every 2nd day, you would save EUR135.15.
