In general, there are two types of papers used in stencil wiping: papers made with synthetic fibers held together with glues (called binders), and papers made from a mix of natural and synthetic fibers that ...

Wiping the stencil with a solvent (cleaning agent) can prevent these defects and avoid inadequate deposition of paste as well as eliminate flux build-up that can affect the release of the paste.

Effectively removes all types of solder paste (e.g. water-based, RMA, no-clean, lead-free) and uncured adhesive from screens, misprinted boards and equipment. Completely safe on stencils, squeegees, ...

Solvent-aqueous understencil wipe solvents appeared to clean well but were slower to dry, and may require additional dry wipe and vacuum steps to ensure complete removal.

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Scrubbing/Wiping: Gently scrub the stencil apertures with a soft, non-abrasive brush or wipe to ensure all residue is fully removed. Be careful not to damage the aperture walls. Final Rinse ...

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
